The Bible Does Not Contradict Scientific Facts

Herbert Spencer (1820 -1903) spent a lifetime searching and finally declared, “there are five fundamentals of science.

If Mr. Spencer had only read the first verse in the Bible, he could have saved himself a lifetime of searching.

Genesis 1:1 “In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.”
